CHEMICAL AGENTS INSTRUCTOR

- PURPOSE:** This course prepares students to teach the 8-hour chemical agents course required for all peace officers. In addition, students will learn basic tactics for chemical agent deployment, aspects of various chemical agents munitions, and liability issues associated with use of pepper spray and other law enforcement chemical agents.
- This course is a basic course for officers who are to be assigned to teach how to use chemical agents. This class meets the instructor training requirements for chemical agents as specified in regulation 1070.
- Note:** Students will be exposed to CN, CS, and OC chemical agents. THIS COURSE IS NOT DESIGNED FOR SWAT TEAM MEMBERS.

- CANCELLATION POLICY:** Cancellations received 15 business days prior to the first day of class are eligible for a full refund. All fees are non-refundable within 15 business days of the first day of class. This class requires a minimum enrollment of students. Should the class be cancelled, students will be notified 15 business days prior to the first day of class.
- PARKING:** A parking permit is not required for exempt vehicles. A daily \$2.00 parking permit is required for all other vehicles; the permit can be purchased from one of the parking machines located in the parking lots.
- Students may not park in any area painted orange or marked as STAFF parking. This includes marked and un-marked police vehicles.
- EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:** Students should bring duty belts, handcuffs, and clothing suitable for exposure to chemical agents.
