First Aid / CPR Instructor

- PURPOSE:** This course is intended to train law enforcement personnel to teach P.O.S.T. certified first aid and CPR classes. The course includes an overview of California laws and regulations associated with peace officer first aid and CPR training standards, and use of AED equipment. Students will learn how to use adult learning methodologies and how to design effective training specifically for law enforcement personnel.

- CANCELLATION POLICY:** Cancellations received 15 business days prior to the first day of class are eligible for a full refund. Should the class be cancelled, students will be notified 15 business days prior to the first day of class.
